### 1. USE OF GIBSON PARK IS AT THE RISK OF THE USERS.

### 2. ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE PROHIBITED

**3.** Pavilion Use – I agree to leave the pavilion in a condition appropriate for the next user by properly disposing of debris, food waste and foil from grills.

**4. DO NOT MOVE OR Transport tables from other areas**. I understand that I am responsible to return the tables to their original location and set appropriately in the picnic pavilion at the end of your event. Picnic tables must NOT be relocated to/from the assigned area.

**5. Maintain facilities** with proper disposal of all garbage, refuse, food waste and rubbish shall be removed from premises or placed in the dumpsters provided. All lids on dumpsters will be closed to help to prevent wildlife and weather from scattering garbage.

**6.** NO LOUD NOISES OR MUSIC SHALL BE PERMITTED: echoes create a disturbance to surrounding areas, be considerate of other users in the park as well as nearby residences.

7. NO FIREARMS or FIREWORKS, NO ATV'S or SNOWMOBILES shall be permitted on grounds.

8. NO PETS PERMITTED except those assisting the disabled.

#### 9. NO SWIMMING IN POND

**10.** All fires shall be tended at all times and thoroughly extinguished before leaving the park.

The park facilities are being maintained at taxpayers' expenses. The Township requests the licensee to exercise due diligence to prevent damage to any part of the park facilities and to exercise control of the behavior of the licensee's party and guests so as to prevent any annoyance or injury to any person, as far as reasonably possible. The area is to be left in satisfactory condition or the licensee will be responsible for additional charges incurred. Licensee agrees to take responsibility for the care thereof; and that safe practices and procedures recommended by the Commonwealth and the CDC during the COVID-19 pandemic will be implemented.
